We kicked off our ambitious McKinley Million Campaign on May 29 at Oahu Country Club and we were very happy to honor and thank Zippy's co-founder and McKinley alum Charlie Higa Class of '49 and his wife Helen for their generous lead gift at this wonderful event. The goal of the McKinley Million Campaign is to grow our endowment from its current base of \$750,000 to \$1 million in order to enable us to continue to invest in the talent and potential of the students of McKinley High School. Since 1990, the McKinley Foundation has awarded over \$1 million in scholarships to over 713 deserving graduates. According to a report from loan giant Sallie Mae, the typical American family relies on scholarships and grants to cover 30 percent of college costs. Given that the cost of a college education has consistently had the highest rate of inflation for years, the need to be able to provide scholarships for as many McKinley students as possible is a challenge that the McKinley Foundation is committed to meet.
