This beginning of the Foundation in 1989 happily coincided with the observance of the 125th anniversary of the founding of McKinley High School. The Foundation could materially assist in the celebration of this historic anniversary.

On May 5, 1989, an application was filed with the State of Hawaii Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs to establish a non-profit corporation. The incorporation was approved on June 14, 1989.

The first Board of Directors meeting was held on June 22, 1989, at McKinley High School. The initial officers were: President Richard Kosaki '42, First Vice President Stanley Seki '57, Second Vice President Jann Yuen '52, Treasurer Harold Hee '42, Recording Secretary Susan Isa '62, Corresponding Secretary Suzanne Nakano '75. The Directors were Richard Ito '79, Carole Kai '62, Allen Kajioka '52, Terence Kimura '57, Patricia Labez '76, Lester Nakaichi '54, Jack Tsui '74 and Jess Walters (representing parents). The initial board of 14 later that year was increased to a board of 35 members.

Organizational matters had to be dealt with. The By-Laws went through several revisions before being adopted in late 1989. Application for the essential tax-exempt status (501-c-3) was filed with the U.S. Internal Revenue Service on August 27, 1989. This legal procedure was expedited by the pro bono legal services provided by Raymond S. Iwamoto '58 of the law firm of Goodwill Anderson Quinn & Stifel. The tax-exempt status was granted on December 12, 1989.

The all-important fund-raising responsibility, while shared by all directors, fell primarily on the shoulders of treasurer Harold Hee, who did an outstanding job in securing some major commitments early in the campaign. During the first year of operation, the Foundation was able to garner approximately \$150,000 in contributions and an additional \$40,000 in pledges. The Board decided to set aside an initial amount of \$100,000 in endowment fund to assure the continuance of the Foundation. While the hiring of an "executive director" was deemed desirable, it was decided to postpone such and appointment until a later time when the Foundation's assets were greater. Many volunteers performed the necessary administrative chores and kept these expenses to a minimum.

The first annual report was filed by the President on September 20, 1990.

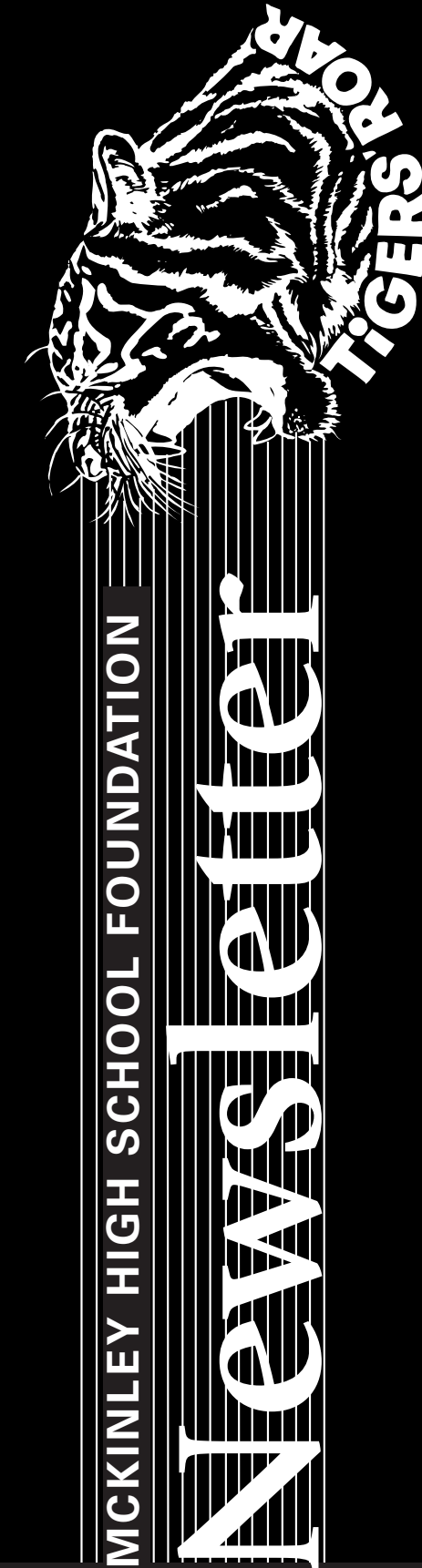
Where we are today

In 1990 the Foundation awarded the first scholarship to a McKinley graduating senior, since those early days the Foundation has awarded scholarships to 916 graduating seniors totaling over \$1,320,000. Because of the generosity of alumni and friends of McKinley High School, including the McKinley Million Campaign, we are able to continue assisting the school in funding projects and are proud to offer financial assistance to students wishing to further their education. We know that Dr. Kosaki would be so very proud of the stability of the Foundation. Because of his vision and that of Stan Seki, many students have been recipients of a good education. In 2013 the Board of Directors of the Foundation established two scholarships in honor of Dr. Richard Kosaki and Stanley Seki in perpetuity. A huge mahalo to both of these "Proud Tigers" and a heartfelt aloha to Dr. Kosaki.
